



The Internet Infrastructure Coalition (i2Coalition) Issues Statement On FCC December Net Neutrality Vote

Washington DC; November 21st, 2017 - The i2Coalition has issued a statement calling on FCC commissioners to vote no on the December 14th net neutrality vote, which was announced earlier today.
