

OhioLINK Selects BiblioBoard for Statewide Shared E-book Collections; Project to Emphasize Digital User Experience

COLUMBUS, Ohio (February 7, 2018) - With the objective of creating a modern and simple digital user experience for students, faculty and researchers, OhioLINK announced today the selection of BiblioBoard as the technology platform for their shared e-book collections.

BiblioBoard, created by BiblioLabs, is an award winning e-content delivery platform that delivers all pieces of a digital library in a single user interface (e-books, audio, videos, historical materials, etc.). The platform is built for simplicity and ease-of-use for the modern user and supports bookmarking, taking notes, storing favorites, and an app for use on Android and iOS.

“This is a much-needed modernization of a legacy e-book platform,” said OhioLINK Executive Director Gwen Evans. “More than 160,000 e-books will now be easily accessible remotely and on devices, which is crucial for the way our members interact with and use information.”

Accessible to more than 600,000 OhioLINK users through its 120 academic and research member libraries, the e-book collection is also used for course materials in classroom instruction at no cost to students. One of the first library consortia in the nation to build a shared collection of high-quality, scholarly e-books, OhioLINK’s collection is available to member institutions at a significant size and discount over what members could afford on their own.

BiblioBoard CEO Mitchell Davis said, “OhioLINK is an industry leader and we appreciate greatly the confidence they have shown in our technology and our vision for the future of libraries. Everyone is looking for a simple and effective digital user experience that crosses mobile elegantly and exceeds user expectations. We have proven the impact we can have in higher ed learning environments and we intend to make this partnership a role model for how vendors and consortia can work collaboratively to achieve that goal in a sustainable way.”

Over the past two years, BiblioBoard has been involved with a number of important academic e-content initiatives, including supporting an industry-leading, Jisc-funded Open Educational Resources (OER) textbook project pilot at the University of Liverpool, and deploying cloud libraries for a number of leading open access projects such as [Knowledge Unlatched](#) and the Public Library of Science (PLOS), among others. The BiblioBoard platform currently hosts over 30,000 open access resources and OER textbooks that are made free as part of the BiblioBoard platform.
