

Peer Review Week 2022 theme poll announced

May 19, 2022 — The Peer Review Week steering committee is seeking input from members of the scholarly community to choose a theme for this year's Peer Review Week events, which will take place from the 19th through the 23rd of September 2022.

The committee has announced the release of an open global theme poll, which includes five possible theme options for Peer Review Week 2022. The committee invites editors, publishers, researchers, members of scholarly and scientific societies, librarians, funders, and anyone interested in the advancement of high-quality research to take the public poll. This is the second year that the committee is inviting the community to choose the Peer Review Week theme. The committee also put out a poll last year to choose the theme for Peer Review Week 2021.

"We're excited to be doing an open poll for Peer Review Week theme selection again this year," said Steering Committee Co-Chair and Head of Marketing at Scholastica Danielle Padula. "It's important to us that Peer Review Week is a collaborative event with input and participation from all scholarly communication stakeholders. Seeking theme options from members of our committee who represent diverse viewpoints and putting theme selection to a public vote is one way we're working to do that. Last year we got over 380 theme poll responses and we hope to get even more this time."

"Peer Review Week has always been a community-led event, and its success depends wholly on the global academic and publishing community," added Steering Committee Co-Chair and Senior Manager, for Global Community Engagement at CACTUS Jayashree Rajagopalan. "This is an open invitation to anyone interested in and passionate about peer review and the role it plays in the dissemination of reliable, high-quality research. Cast your vote. Tell us what Peer Review Week 2022 should be all about."
